

Notice to Exhibitors

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this event, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the event committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the event committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the complete, accurate and legible information on the entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.

Speedway Games – General rules and example courses

Courses are set to 100 yards with maximum standard course time of 60 seconds. Going over 60 seconds is “NQ. “
Declared training in ring (DTIR) allowed – NO FOOD, Squeaky, crinkle or noise toys. Toys cannot leave handler – no throwing.

Non-Qualifying Run (NQ)

1. Handler touching dog or obstacles or intentionally blocks obstacles.
2. Not completing the course in sequence. (can correct off course and refusals- just adds time)
3. Food in the ring or dog fouling in ring at any time.
4. Dogs may not knock over obstacles before completing them. If knocked over and not useable, then NQ.
5. Dog leaves the ring, quits working, is out of control or handler has toys in the ring – Note: DTIR is NQ.
6. In team games, two dogs may not be running on course at the same time. Dog 1 must finish before dog 2 starts.

POINTS: The dog's time for a run determines the division and points earned:

Division	Course time range	Point calculation	Possible points range
I	38 s to 60 s	60 s -the dog's time	Up to 22 points
II	34 s to 37.99 s	$22 + (38 \text{ s} - \text{the dog's time}) \div 2$	22 to 24 points
III	28 s to 33.99 s	$24 + (34 \text{ s} - \text{the dog's time}) \div 3$	24 to 26 points
IV	24 s to 27.99 s	$27 + (28 \text{ s} - \text{the dog's time}) \div 4$	27 to 28 points
V	up to 23.99 s	$28 + (24 \text{ s} - \text{the dog's time}) \div 5$	28 and above points

TITLES: Points are totaled from all Speedway games and are cumulative once dog earns points.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. 1st through 3rd place are awarded ribbons. Dogs with No Time are not eligible for ribbons. New Title ribbons will be awarded.

EXERCISE YOUR DOG RESPONSIBLY! Pick up after your dog at the show site and the hotels. All dogs must be on a leash except when in the ring. There is a leash law in Nebraska

VOLUNTEERS: Trials run smoother with your help!

Please sign up to work. A worker sign-up form will be at the trial. Don't worry if you don't know how to do a job! They are easy and we can show you how!

CRATING: There is crating space available indoors on hard surface floor. You can crate out of your vehicle if desired. Parking is convenient to the entrance. No expens. We anticipate the trial will run for a little over 2 hours.

FOOD/REFRESHMENT: Soft drinks, water, snacks etc. are available for purchase at the Off the Wall Bar.

CPE general Speedway trial rules: (see the online rulebook at www.k9cpe.com for further info on divisions and complete details.)

- Dogs must be at least 12 months or older the first day of the trial.
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.
- No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: stitches, wraps, boots or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep the hair out of the dogs eyes. At the discretion of the handler a dog may wear one (1) flat buckle or round (leather) collar with no tags or anything attached. If a dog starts a run with anything attached to a collar it is a non-qualifying run. Prong collars are not allowed on site.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar & leash, quick release harness or head halter/leader.
- Handlers may carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, the leash must be in a pocket, out of sight of the dog.
- Dogs must be under the handler's control when leaving the ring.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10' feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.
- The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course.
