PRIZES AND AWARDS: Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. 1 st through 3 rd place are awarded ribbons. Dogs with No Time/NQ are not eligible for ribbons. New Title ribbons will be awarded. Brag Tags for placements, qualifying runs and all Speedway titles are offered as option to ribbons.
