Paper Entry Information:

Email confirmations will be sent to those providing a legible email address on their entry form. If you would like to receive your entry status by USPS prior to the issuance of the preliminary judging schedule at closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

- Only one dog per entry form, include AKC titles only. JUMP HEIGHT REQUIRED.
- All entries must be original copies submitted on official AKC Agility Entry Forms (attached) and must include an attached signed AKC agreement. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are **NOT** acceptable and will not be entered into the trial (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 4).
- Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted with mailed entries.
- Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; and 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier services, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. Please waive signature requirements on all forms of delivery. **Mail requiring signatures will be returned to the sender.**
- A maximum of ten (10) entries per envelope are allowed. Envelopes with more than ten (10) entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries.
- Make checks out to **Platte Valley Kennel Club (PVKC)**.
- A returned check charge of \$35 will be leveled.
- Transfers are accepted as per AKC rules.

Directions To The Trial Site

Companion Dog Club is located at roughly 1/2 mile south of Highway 36 & 72nd Street in Omaha, Nebraska. It is 1.2 miles North of the I-680 & 72nd Street Intersection.

The Companion Dog Club facility is a large, white, one story, metal building on the west side of 72nd Street. It is the first building located on the left in the old North Omaha “Radar Center” as you approach from the South. Use the southern gate to access the facility. Parking is in front of the building.

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries After Closing Date/Time

A wait list will be kept until Monday, September 9th, 2024 to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial’s closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the wait list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the wait list close date will receive a full refund (less PayPal fees) or their check will be destroyed depending on entry method.

Junior Ribbons and Awards

In addition to any regular placements, Juniors will be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places for each class for qualifying runs.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs must be 6 months or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Privileges (PAL/ILP), and AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. PVKC allows dogs owned by club members on the trial committee to enter. This includes the trial secretary.

Notice to Exhibitors

- Telephone, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- Make all checks and money orders payable to Platte Valley Kennel Club (PVKC) All fees must be payable in US funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Payment will be held until the closing date of the event.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee or AKC.
- The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance; and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the trial before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made. No entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Platte Valley Kennel Club reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.
- Owners are responsible for errors on completed entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes,

additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by telegram, or e-mail prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

- Refunds will not be given for a change of entry. Owners may write a new or additional check. No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A collection fee of \$35 will be added to the amount of each returned check.
- Checks for withdrawn entries will be shredded. No check will be returned.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Bitches coming in season after the closing date will receive a refund of their entry fee less a \$6 administrative fee provided that the trial secretary is notified prior to the start time of the trial and written verification by a veterinarian is provided.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.
- Class prizes will be distributed in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims must be made in the ring before the judging for that trial is over, and the Secretary advised at once. All ribbons/prizes must be claimed at the trial. No ribbons/prizes will be mailed.
- Platte Valley Kennel Club, the trial secretary, members of the trial committee, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their

employees or children, etc. or to any of their dogs or property. Entrants and spectators to this show do so entirely at their own risk.

- **Lunch and refreshments available on site.**

Safety, Behavior and Liability

- **By entering this trial**, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The Platte Valley Kennel Club and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).
- Platte Valley Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause; and no one shall have any claim or recourse against or any official thereof.
- Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- **All dogs** must be on leash or kenneled at all times when not in the ring.
- **Exhibitors** are expected to comply with the Omaha's Disposal of Dog Waste Ordinance: *Any person having custody or control of any dog shall have the responsibility of disposing of dog feces or manure of the dog in a sanitary manner.*
- **Crates** may be left overnight; however, the Platte Valley Kennel Club and Companion Dog Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

- By entering this trial you are releasing PVKC and the trial facility from any impact or consequences of communicable disease. Be kind, respectful, and do your part to ensure safety of yourself, your dogs and other trial attendees.
- **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The City of Omaha requires a Rabies Vaccinations.
- **All dogs on site MUST belong to an entered competitor.**
- **No Puppies under four months of age are allowed on the trial site.**
- **Entries without jump heights or payment will not be accepted.**

A limited number of catalogs are available for \$5 preordered and \$6 at the trial.

TRANSFERS

Transfers (formerly known as move-ups) will be allowed according to AKC regulations, provided that the written request is received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfers may be submitted prior to the day of the trial by e-mail or regular mail.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.

2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.
3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
